We also made bookmarks and character masks and were lucky to have a story read to us by a different member of the reception team relating to our topic on pirates.

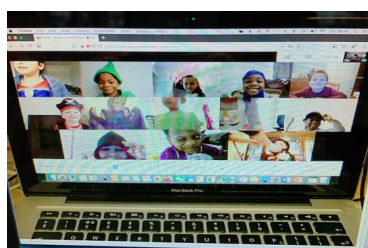

We have spaces in our nursery for children that are 3 years of age before March 31st. Please enquire at the School Office for further information.

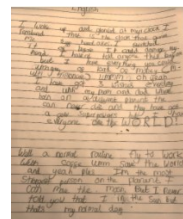
Year 5 World Book Day 2021

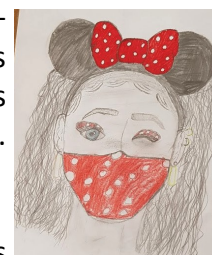


History

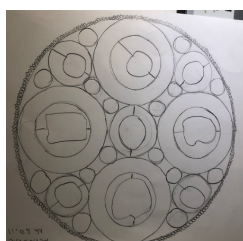


Each week 5TTG class was set a fun challenge to complete as well as starting a hobby to do during their free time, majority of the class did brilliant drawings and sketching.
