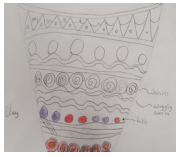


## MEXICO CLASS

Winning designs will be placed in a bulletin board for Display in front of the school.

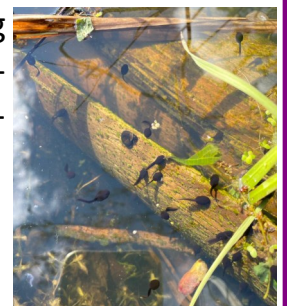
Two best designs from each class will be chosen. No later than 17th May.

In Maths, we have been sharing items into equal and unequal groups. We have been talking about if it is equal then it is fair because you have the same amount. All the children have worked really hard!

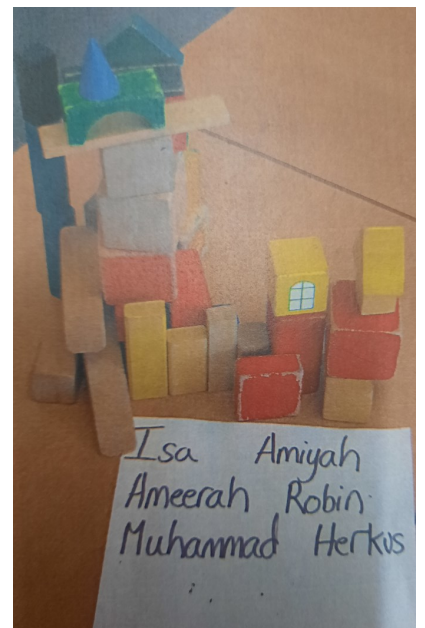
