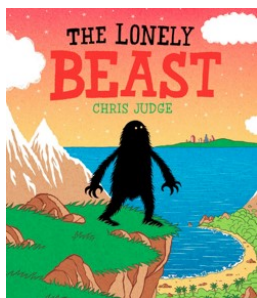

ENGLAND CLASS



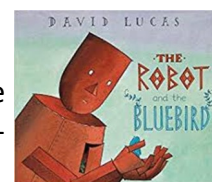
In England Class this week we have learning all about our capital city, London. We drew line drawings of famous landmarks.
