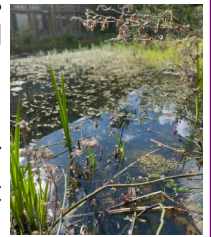


Dear Families,

**We are still aiming to reduce the number of parents and visitors using the entrance area in the morning time. Please continue to drop siblings off with the youngest child in the morning.**

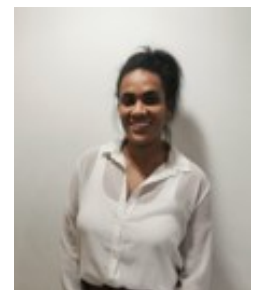
## **PARKING - SCHOOL STREETS**

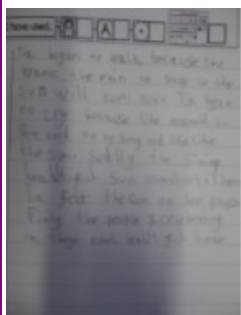

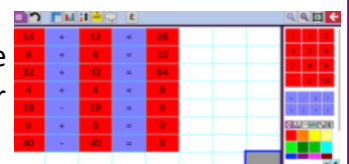
## ROMANIA CLASS

This week in 1R we have been learning about turns and position in maths. We learnt about full turns, half turns, quarter turns and three quarter turns. We used concrete resources to help us. We've also learnt about position and the definition of some of the key vocabulary such as: above, below, top, middle, bottom, next to, under, over, forwards, backwards etc. We used a cuddly toy to model all the positions.



In English this week we have been writing the beginning, middle and end of our innovative story about Tia. The story is based on the book *Lila and the Secret of Rain* which we've really enjoyed for the last three weeks.

In computing we are learning about spreadsheets and how to use them. We used Ipads and worked in pairs making addition number sentences. We have become very good at using spreadsheets now!
