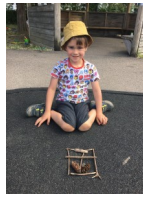
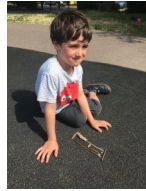


## R1 BUBBLE
