Dear Families,

Thank you all for your support this half term. As always the children have been a credit to you and us.

The focus for this term has been Wellbeing and getting back to learning. The focus on pupil well being has worked very well, as we know how important mental health is. The themes for this term have been: BELIEVEING in YOURSELF, HOPE, KINDESS, GRATITUDE & PHYSICAL HEALTH V MENTAL HEALTH. The well being recovery curriculum has been a core part of us all integrating back together as a school.

In our school the policy on behaviour is to focus on the behaviour we want to see in class and around school and not the behaviour we don't. Each class has a 'Recognition Board' where we celebrate and recognise the positive learning behaviours we want to see in class.

The Junior Leadership team have reviewed the behaviour policy recently and have suggested we share with all of your their views for behaviour in our school.

We do not tolerate bullying in our school, we are a diverse school and we celebrate our unique qualities.

Inline with our behaviour policy if your child is reported to be unkind in any way either verbally of physically towards another child you will be called to a meeting to discuss how we can support you and your children to meet our schools expectations. If any parents are concerned about any relationships with children in school or out of hours, please let a member of the senior leadership team know so we can deal with it as any matters arise.

You will already know from the consultation in the Autumn term the Department for Education has reviewed the **Relationships & Sex Education (RSE)** curriculum we as a school have adapted our curriculum to meet the requirement and have taken on board any views shared during the consultation.

There are four main aims of teaching RSE:

- To enable children to understand and respect their body
- To help children develop positive and healthy relationships appropriate to their age and development
- To support children to have positive self-esteem and body image
- To empower them to be safe and safeguarded.

Each year group will be taught appropriate to their age and developmental stage. At no point will a child be taught something that is inappropriate. Science


We are studying plants and what they need to survive. The children have planted their own sunflower seeds, as part of an investigation.


