Situation	Action	When can my child return to school?
My child has Covid symptoms.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • DO NOT COME TO SCHOOL • Contact school to tell us. • Self-isolate the whole household and support bubble. • Book a test for ALL people in the house who have Covid symptoms. 	<p>If the test is negative for everyone in the household who had symptoms.</p> <p>If they feel well and 10 days have passed since they had symptoms.</p>
I cannot get a test for someone in my house who has Covid symptoms.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • DO NOT COME TO SCHOOL • Contact school to tell us. • If you cannot get a test within 5 days then everyone in your house MUST self isolate for 14 days. 	After 14 days.
My child has tested positive for Covid-19.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • DO NOT COME TO SCHOOL • Contact us as soon as you know this. • Self -isolate the whole household or support bubble. 	<p>After 10 days if they are well even if they still have a cough or a loss of taste or smell.</p> <p>A COUGH AND LOSS OF TASTE AND SMELL CAN LAST LONGER THAN 10 DAYS BUT DO NOT COME BACK IF YOU STILL HAVE A HIGH TEMPERATURE.</p>
My child has tested negative for Covid-19.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Contact school to tell us and we will advise you when to come back to school. 	<p>If the test is negative and everyone in the house WITH SYMPTOMS has tested negative.</p> <p>If they feel well and no longer have symptoms.</p> <p>If they do, the whole household needs to continue to self-isolate.</p>

<p>Someone in my house or support bubble has Covid symptoms.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● DO NOT COME TO SCHOOL. ● Contact school to tell us. ● Self-isolate the whole household and support bubble. ● Book a test for ALL people in the house who have Covid symptoms. 	<p>The test comes back negative.</p>
<p>NHS track and trace has identified my child as a close contact of somebody with symptoms of Covid or a positive Covid-19 test.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● DO NOT COME TO SCHOOL. ● Contact school to tell us. 	<p>Once the child has completed 14 days self-isolation</p>
<p>NHS track and trace has identified a member of the household as a close contact of somebody with symptoms of Covid or a positive Covid-19 test.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● The household member must self-isolate for 14 days. 	<p>The child can come to school UNLESS they or another member of the household develops symptoms.</p>
<p>A brother or sister or any member of the household has been sent home to self-isolate because there has been a positive case in their school.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● The person who has been sent home must isolate for 14 days. 	<p>Rushey Green children can continue to come to school UNLESS they get Covid symptoms or someone else in their house gets symptoms.</p>
<p>My child's class or bubble is closed due to a positive case of Covid.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● DO NOT COME TO SCHOOL ● Your child in this bubble will need to self-isolate for 14 days. ● Brothers and sisters can come to school unless anyone in the house shows symptoms. 	<p>Once school informs you that the bubble is re-opened.</p>
<p>My child is poorly with sickness and diarrhoea.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● DO NOT COME TO SCHOOL ● Contact school to tell us 	<p>After 48 hours if they are well.</p>
<p>My child is poorly with non-Covid symptoms.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● DO NOT COME TO SCHOOL ● Contact school to tell us 	<p>Once the child is well again.</p>
