

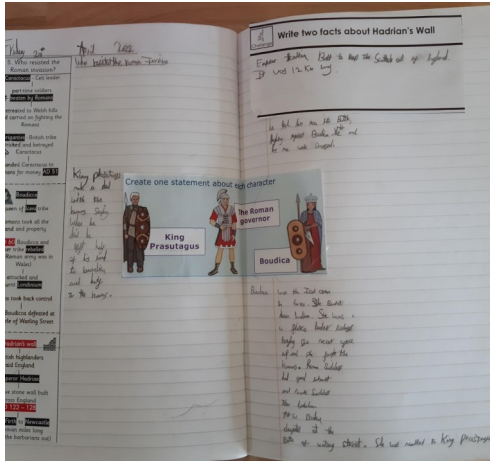

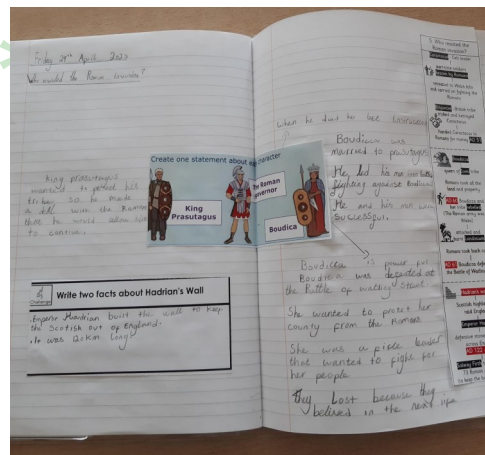


# BRAZIL CLASS

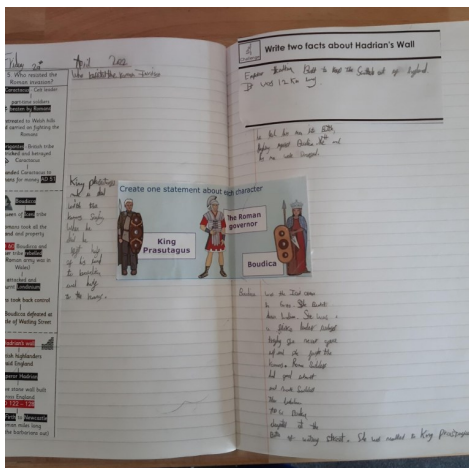
This term, Brazil Class has been immersed in learning about the Roman Empire and its impact on Britain.



3B students have applied what they have learnt in history to create a story based on the battle between the Romans and the queen of the Iceni tribe, Boudicca.

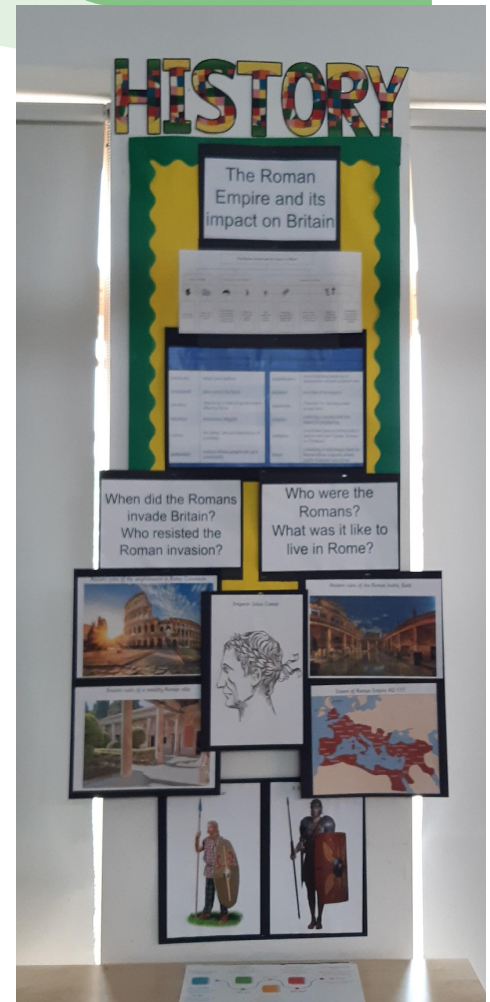


Through rich discussion and valuable texts, students have learnt about the resistance towards Roman invasions, including key influencers such as Caractacus and Boudicca.

They have captured the reader's attention and entertained them by using their wonderful knowledge and imagination.

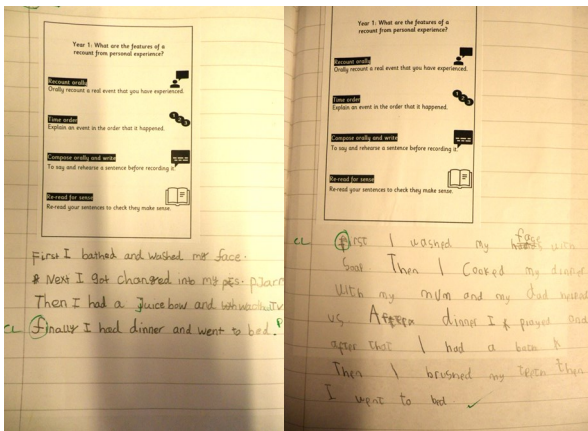


## WHAT'S NEXT?

In English this week we have been learning about recounts.

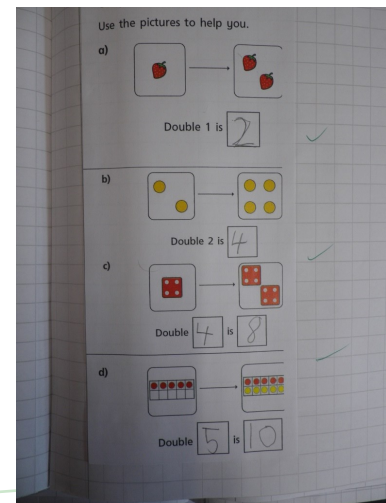
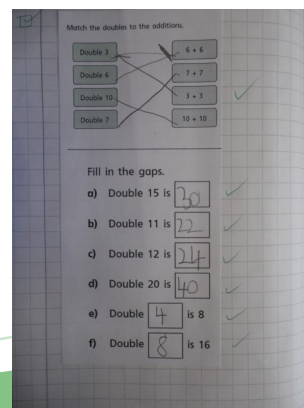
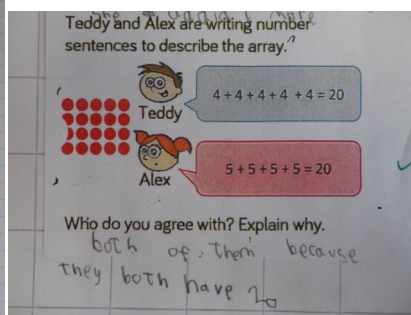
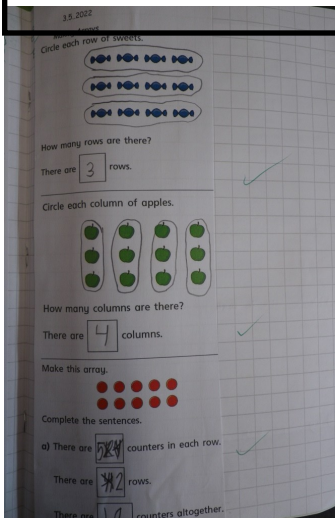


We know that a recount is a piece of text that provides, in detail, the happenings of a previous event and that recounts are written in the order in which they happen; chronological order.

We used time conjunctions such as: first, next, then and finally in our recounts. We had to think about what we do after school in the evenings at home and write a recount about that. First we wrote a plan and then the final recount.

In maths we have been learning about arrays. An array in maths is an arrangement of objects, numbers or pictures in columns and rows. (The purpose of an array is to help children understand multiplication and division). We found it a bit tricky at first but we soon figured it out.

We have also been learning about doubling, which we really enjoyed!
