




BRAZIL CLASS

3B students have applied what they have learnt in history to create a story based on the battle between the Romans and the queen of the Iceni tribe, Boudicca.






Through rich discussion and valuable texts, students have learnt about the resistance towards Roman invasions, including key influencers such as Caractacus and Boudicca.

They have captured the reader's attention and entertained them by using their wonderful knowledge and imagination.




WHAT'S NEXT?

ROMANIA CLASS

In English this week we have been learning about recounts.



We know that a recount is a piece of text that provides, in detail, the happenings of a previous event and that recounts are written in the order in which they happen; chronological order.

In maths we have been learning about arrays. An array in maths is an arrangement of objects, numbers or pictures in columns and rows. (The purpose of an array is to help children understand multiplication and division). We found it a bit tricky at first but we soon figured it out.

Teddy and Alex are writing number sentences to describe the array.

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
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


