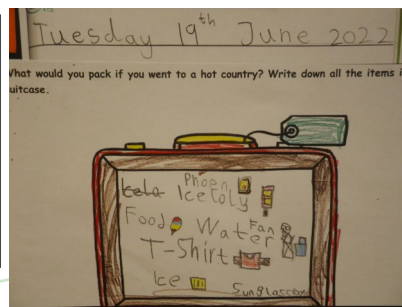
Writing Assessment

Leavers trip, Assembly and even including an end of year disco....

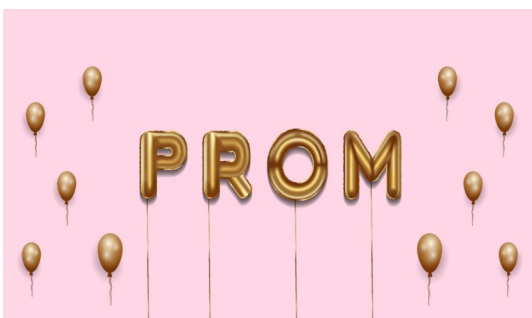

An outdoor Gozney Pizza oven

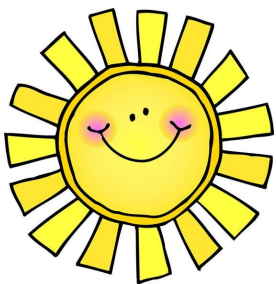
