


# TURKEY CLASS


Year 1 have enjoyed lots of new learning this week and the weather too! In Maths, the children have been introduced to fractions. Learning about halves of shapes.

It was great to see how children had shown each cast member's character through their words.


After using a teacher model and analysing and practising how to

We have looked at how to draw and calculate angles around a point and angles on a straight line.


Here's a flavour of some of the work the children have been doing:

# NURSERY


This term in nursery we've been looking at technology in a variety of different contexts

We've been looking at outer space and the technology surrounding it, thinking about the planets and stars, but also spaceships, rockets and different forms of communication.




We've been learning about

shapes, thinking about how we can put them together in different ways to make familiar images. Someone here has used some squares and a triangle to make a Rocketship!




