This term our topic is... Mini beasts

Over the course of this half term the children will be spending as much time as possible in the outdoor areas during their designated times. Each class will also have two sessions a week where they will go to a nature section of the playground and carry out activities linked to forest school. There we will be looking for mini beasts and bugs and comparing the similarities and differences.

In literacy the nursery children will continue to learn to write their name as well as starting the letters and sounds phonics programme. Reception children will continue to consolidate their phonic knowledge and continue to write simple CVC words and sentences.

In maths the nursery children will be looking at number, using numicon and the reception children will be investigating weight and capacity, along with time and money.

Our PE lessons this term will take place outside for all children on a **Thursday**. Children will carry out the PE lesson in their school uniform, so therefore please make sure they are wearing trousers or tracksuit bottoms on this day, with trainers or plimsoles. (Please do not send your child to school with a PE kit in a bag)

Sun cream and sun hats



As the weather has been very hot and sunny recently please make sure you apply a high factor sun lotion to your child each day before they come to school as we are unable to apply this to them. Also they will need to bring in a named sun hat.

Ways to extend your child's learning

- Go on a mini beast hunt around your garden or park
- Make spider handprints
- Make a mini beast out of recycled boxes
- Make a creepy crawly picture
- Read the story of the hungry caterpillar
- Make a fruit salad

Spare clothes

If your child is in nursery please can you ensure that you bring in a spare set of clothes for your child, should they get wet or have a toilet accident throughout the day. This bag must be named and will be left on their peg. If reception parents would also like to leave a spare set of clothes for their child they may do so as well.



Water bottles





Please ensure you send your child to school everyday with a named reusable water bottle, not the single use plastic ones. These bottles must only contain water, no juice or fizzy drinks please. Children will not have access to water fountains during this current time.
