Grammar schools


Independent schools (Fee paying and private / or funded if your child has an EHCP)

# All schools will allocate places according to their admission policies

Generic pattern for priorities include:

- Pupils with EHCPs
- Children who are looked after, previously looked after or under a special guardianship order
- siblings
- distance

What mainstream secondary schools in Lewisham can I apply to for my child?












# Important information

From the 1st September 2022 you can apply for a school place for September 2023. You can apply for a place in:

- A Primary school (Reception)
- A Junior school (Year 3)
- A Secondary school (Year 7)
- A University Technical College (Year 10)
- . In some areas you can apply for a place in:
- A Nursery class or school (Age 3+)

If you require a school place for your child now (In Year) please contact your home Local Authority.





- The person completing the application must be the child's parent (including adoptive parents) or the person with legal parental responsibility.
- Grandparent or other family member cannot apply unless they have legal parental responsibility.

You will need to provide documentation - proof.

We strongly recommend you read through these documents before you submit your application.

When completing the application form, ensure you pay attention to the following:

• Tick the correct/relevant boxes to your application (e.g. medical, SEND, looked after, siblings)

• Click submit - you will receive your application number

 Provide supplementary information - where requested for your application (please see Mrs Thomas - SENCO - if you require electronic copies of professional reports to upload to your application)

# Special educational needs and disabilities provision and special schools



There are four special schools for children of secondary school age are Greenvale, New Woodlands, Drumbeat and Brent Knoll, as well schools in neighbouring local authorities. There are also resource bases within Conisborough College, Deptford Green and Addey and Stanhope.

Most children with special educational and needs and disabilities (SEND) go to a mainstream school which has specific provision and policies accommodating to the needs of the child who have SEND.

If your child has an EHCP, the application process is different, and you will need to apply online, on the Lewisham website by 1st October.

**Thursday 1st September 2022**: Applications open (apply online)

**Saturday 1st October 2022:** Deadline for applications for pupils with EHCPs

**Monday 31st October 2022**: Deadline dates for applications but recommended you apply by Monday 24th October 2022)

**Wednesday 1st March 2023**: Results for applications (parents/carers will receive an email in the evening)

Wednesday 15th March 2023: Deadline to accept offers online

Wednesday 29th March 2023: Closing dates for appeals (may change)

May/June 2023: Appeals hearing (may change)

Wednesday 5th July 2023: Induction day at secondary school (may change)
