This term our topic is... settlement and land use

In English this half term, we will be exploring a 'Power of Reading' book called 'Pig heart boy' by Malorie Blackman. Through this interesting text we will be looking at different genres of writing. In destination reader, the books the children will be immersed in are: Surprising Joy, Thief in the village and Journey to Jo'burg.

In Maths this half term, we will be focusing on place value, number: subtraction and statistics. This will be taught with a mastery approach ensuring that we are able to allow children the fluency they need, to have a deeper understanding of mathematical concepts.

In Science we will be looking at 'Properties and changes in materials' focusing on comparing materials and looking at their properties, discovering which materials are thermal conductors and electrical conductors. Understanding which materials dissolve and determining which are soluble and insoluble.

We will be finding out about the different stages of development from birth to old age and investigating changes as humans develop throughout their lifespan. We will be experimenting and testing out our predictions and recording data using scientific diagrams and labels.

In Geography our question is 'Where would you choose to build a city?' We will be understanding some of the key physical and human characteristics. Discovering and observing the local area and how the land is used and the types of settlements. Also, the economic activity and trade links between Britain and other European countries. Lastly, children will learn the common features between some European cities and some of Britain's big cities.

In RE we will be exploring the Christian faith and learning about places to visit in Jerusalem and how Jerusalem reminds Christians of the last days of Jesus. Also, to look closely and understand the important ceremonies in the Christian faith.

In DT we will be designing and creating a torch with a switch that controls a bulb on and off. The children will analyse a range of torches used by different people for different purposes. They will

Start and End times to the day
