This term our Geography is... Greece

Our Big question is: What makes London great?

- In English this half term, we are looking at the book The Iron Man by Ted Hughes. We will be learning to use similes, metaphors and personification to make our writing more interesting. As well as learning about how to write a newspaper report. We are planning lots of exciting opportunities for drama to help us understand the text.
- In Maths this half term, we will be learning about fractions and decimals. The children will begin with placing fractions on a number line. Next they will build on their understanding of division to find fractions of amounts. This will also help them to recap on previous knowledge of place value and exchanging tens for ones. The children will move onto applying their knowledge of numerators and denominators to find fractions of amounts and deepen their understanding through problem solving. We will also be investigating equivalent fractions and improper fractions before moving on to decimals.
- In Science we will be looking at States of Matter. The children will learn about types of solids, liquids and gases, how temperature and pressure affect substances in different states and how matter changes states.
- In Geography, we will be learning about the key geographical features of Greece and making comparisons with the United Kingdom. We will focus on what makes Greece unique. We will learn about the physical features, for example, the mountains, forests, rivers and the climate as well as the human features such as population size, economy and tourism.
- In R.E we will be looking at local Christian places of worship and focusing on the importance of belonging to a group and sharing activities with others.
- In Art we will be looking at paintings of landscapes and exploring the use of colour to reflect mood.
