





WELL DONE ON COMPLETING YOUR EXAM!


- You will receive your RAW score for Art subjects this week. (Mrs Charlton-Matthews has emailed her students).

New process for students on report to full student support team or SLT


- All students must, in the first 10 minutes, get their report signed at break and lunch by a member of the full student support team (JCA,PFR,PHA,DST,LNI,HOV,AMI,LMS,VGA,ELI)
- If a student has received a **3** they will lose the break (if it is period 5 the next day).
- If students receive a **4** this is relocation they lose the break and receive the relocation detention.
- If the report has not been signed by a member of the NET team-the student will be placed in solo study for the remainder of the day.


