## Tuesday 21st May

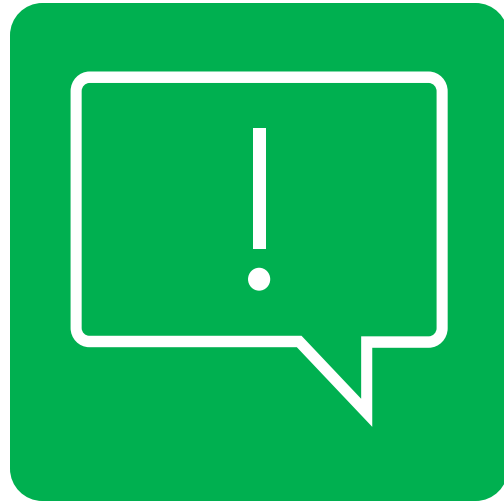
- We are welcoming a group of Year 5 Primary School students into our school to participate in some Rye Advance classes on **Tuesday 21st May**.

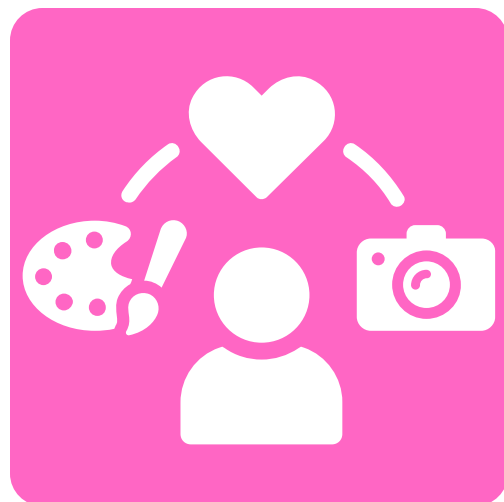

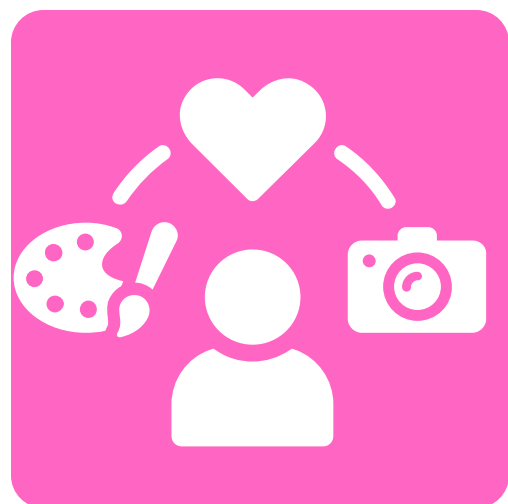
