- Any acts of vandalism will result in a bill being sent home to families and behaviour sanctions will be put in place

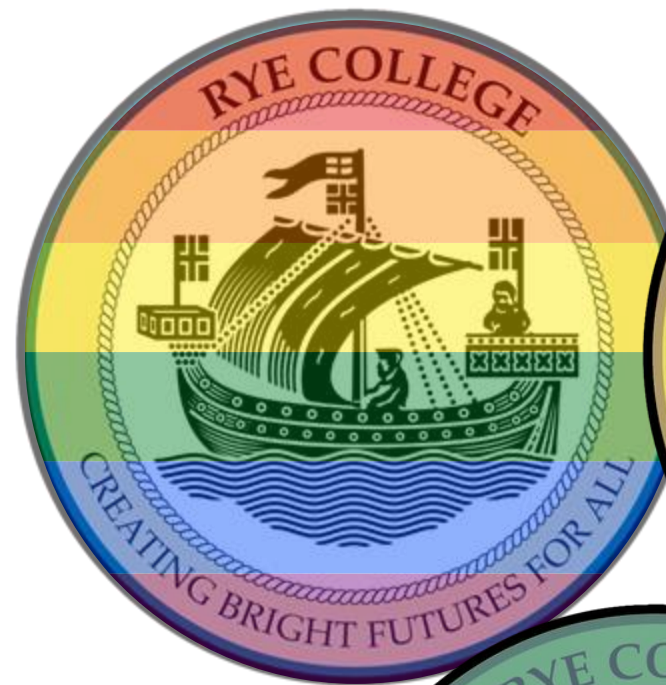
