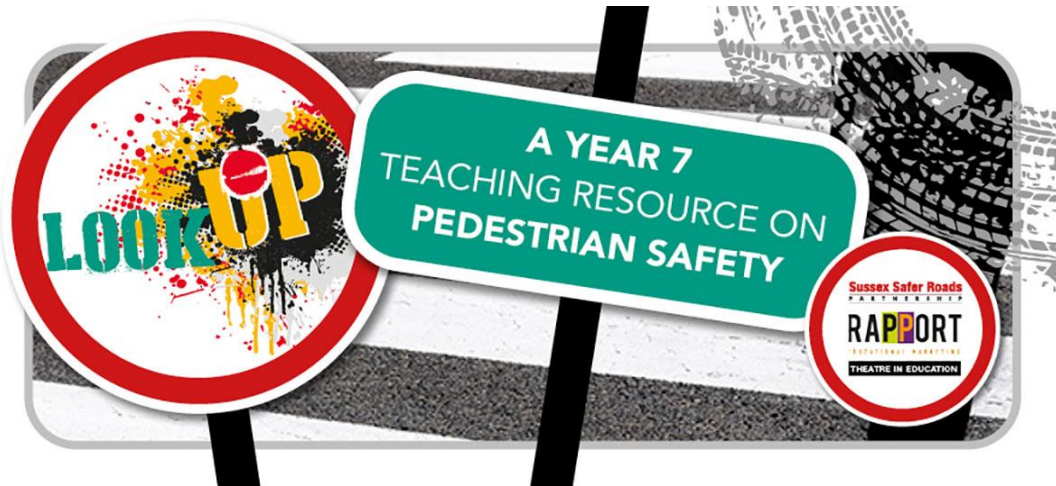

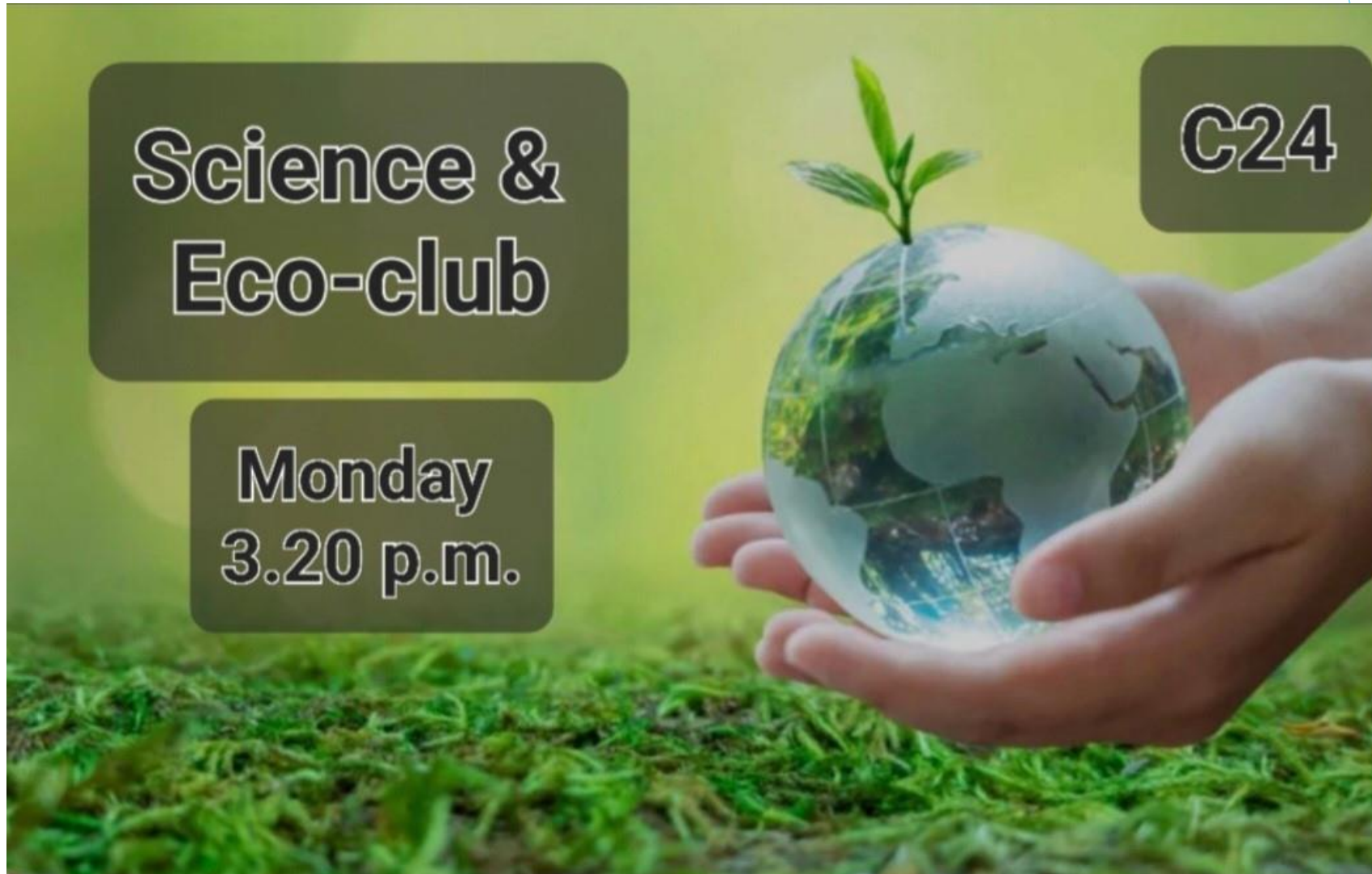

The staff kitchen in this corridor is strictly out of bounds

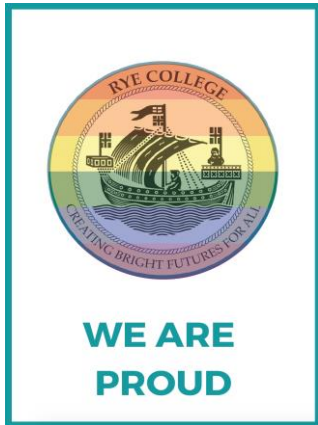
