- ▶ On Wednesday 1st November, ASK Apprenticeships are coming in to deliver an assembly
- ▶ This will be followed by an assessment centre and interview workshop
- ▶ The aim of these activities is to explain apprenticeships in further detail e.g. when/how to apply, levels of apprenticeship, how they work etc, and also to look at potential interview processes and techniques
- ▶ The workshops will run on a carousel basis, with each form group attending for a whole lesson
- ▶ The sessions will take place in the library
- ▶ The running order will be as follows:

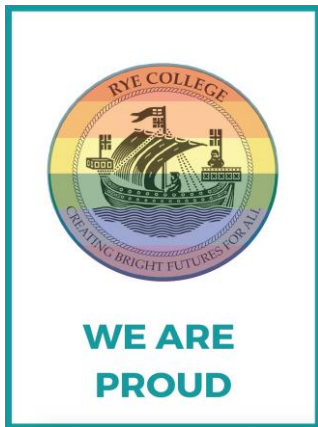
