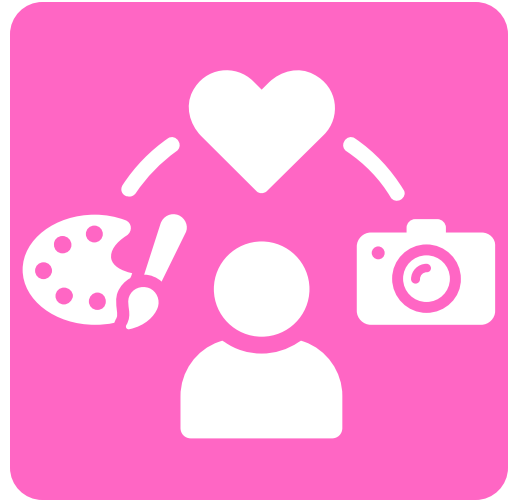

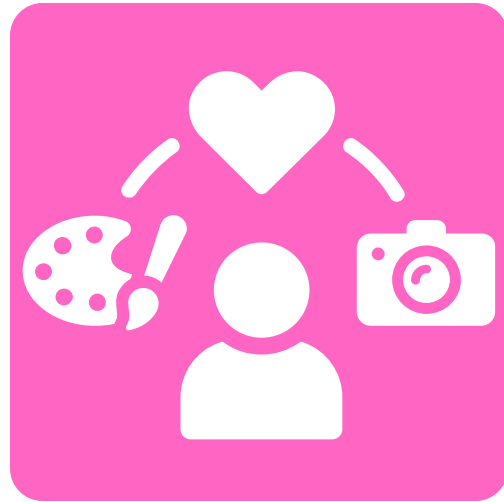

## New process for students on report to full student support team or SLT

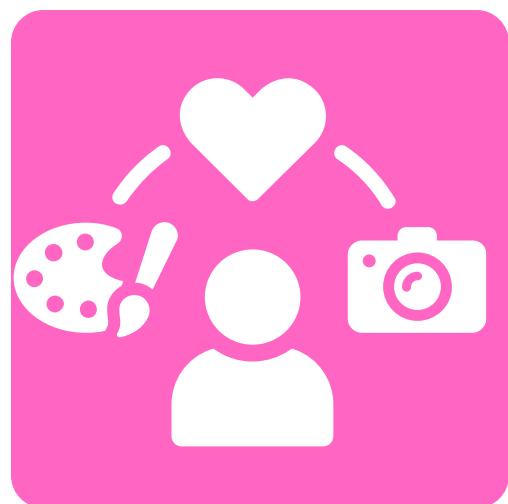

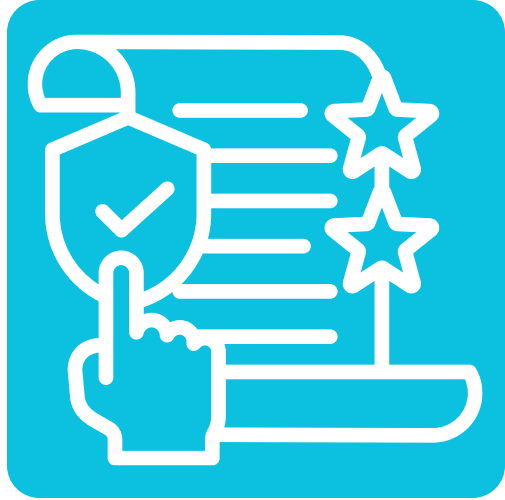

- Any acts of vandalism will result in a bill being sent home to families and behaviour sanctions will be put in place

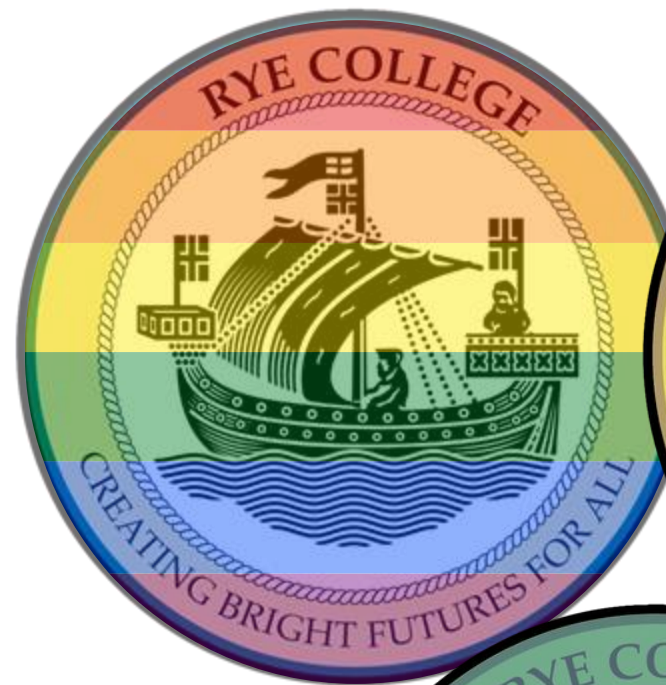
