


Polite reminder – If you pay for your child to have toast every week, this needs to be paid on ParentPay by Monday morning at 09:30am.

This week we wanted to share: **Quick Pitta Pizzas** – Perfect for a quick meal in the school holidays!



Ingredients

4 Whole-wheat pitta breads

4 tsp sun-dried tomato purée

3 Ripe plum tomatoes – diced

50g Mature cheddar – grated

Topping ideas –

Tuna, sweetcorn, ham, mushroom, peppers, chorizo, red onion, pepperoni, chicken, pesto.

Method

Step 1. Heat oven to 200C/180C fan/gas 6 and put a baking sheet inside to heat up. Spread each pitta with 1 tsp purée. Top with the tomatoes, shallot, chorizo and cheddar.

Step 2. Place on the hot sheet and bake for 10 mins until the pittas are crisp, the cheese has melted and the chorizo has frizzled edges. Scatter with basil, if you like, and serve with a green salad.
