- 16th May – Year 1 trip to Haigh Woodland Park

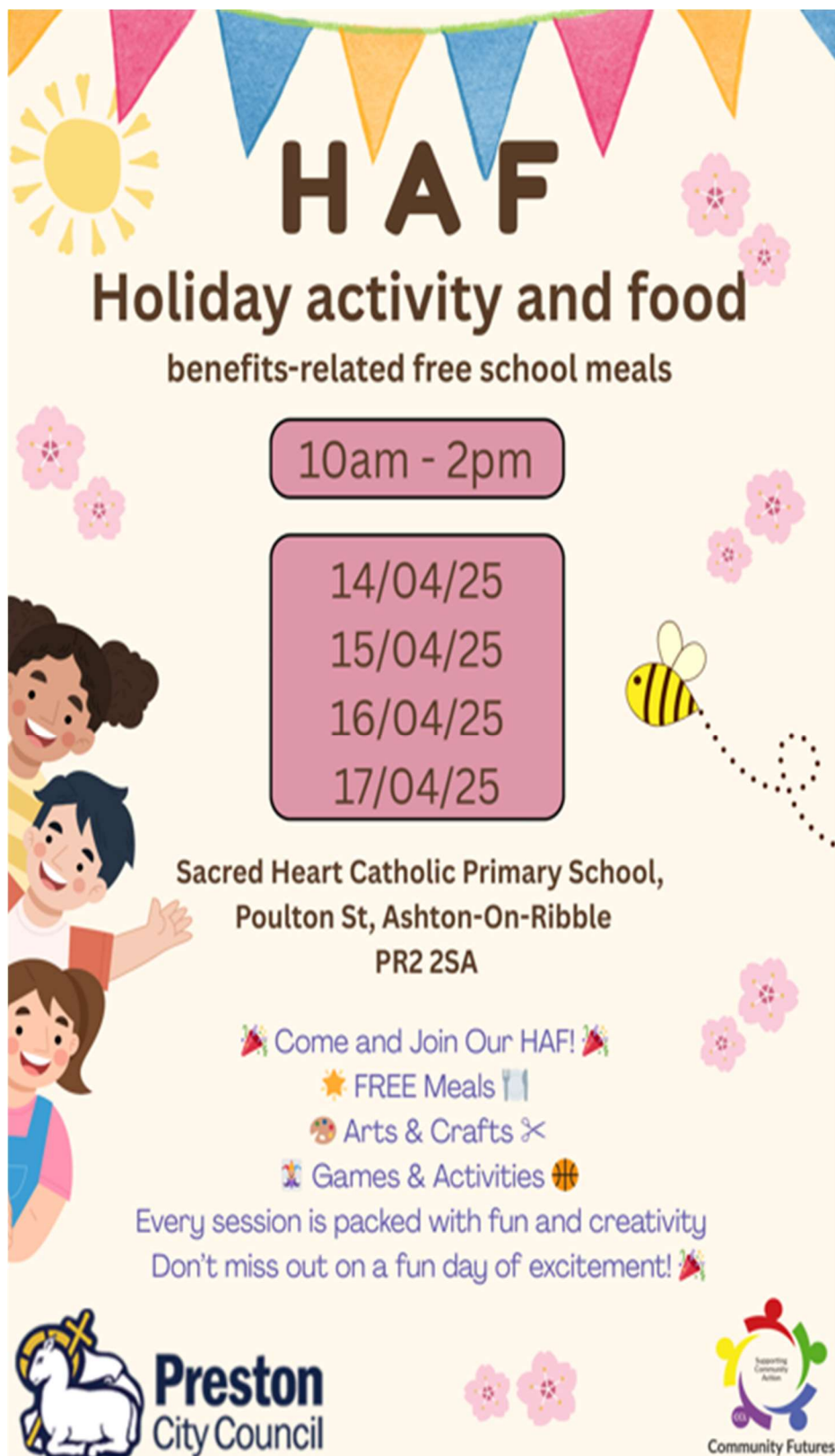
Letters with regards to the trips have gone out and are available for payment on ParentPay.
