Upcoming Strike Days

You will be aware from media reports that the National Education Union (NEU) have recently voted to strike in England and Wales. National teacher strikes are scheduled to take place on Wednesday 5th July and Friday 7th July.

The strike is part of an ongoing national campaign due to the underfunding of schools. Teacher pay is one of the issues of underfunding, as well as strained school budgets, recruitment challenges and the impacts on schools of the cuts to wider services.

At the time of writing we are unsure which classes will be affected by the strike, however when we have any further information we will communicate this as soon as possible.

Uniform

A reminder that children should be in full school uniform every day. The school website details all items that form part of the school policy. Children must also be in appropriate school shoes and not wearing jewellery.

Please could we also ask that children wear the school PE kit. This is red t-shirt, black shorts and a red hoodie/ jumper/ cardigan. We do not allow football shirts, or sportswear different to that as listed above. Children must also be in appropriate footwear.

We ask this not only as it forms part of the school rules, but also for health and safety, as well as safeguarding of our children. Please can we ask parents/ carers to support us in ensuring children come to school in appropriate uniform each day.
