Upcoming Strike Days

You will be aware from media reports that the National Education Union (NEU) have recently voted to strike in England and Wales. National teacher strikes are scheduled to take place on Wednesday 5th July and Friday 7th July.

The strike is part of an ongoing national campaign due to the underfunding of schools. Teacher pay is one of the issues of underfunding, as well as strained school budgets, recruitment challenges and the impacts on schools of the cuts to wider services.

At the time of writing I can confirm Year 2 will be closed on Wednesday 5th July and Year 2 and Year 3 will be closed on Friday 7th July.

If your child is in receipt of free school meals and you would like school to provide a packed lunch for the affected days, please call the school office to advise us on Monday 3rd July.



In preparation for a child imminently due to start with us who has a severe nut allergy, we would like to kindly ask for your full support in becoming a nut free school.

Please can we ask children who bring a packed lunch or snacks for break time to ensure no products containing nuts are brought to school. For example – nuts, peanut butter, snickers and cereal bars.

We already operate a nut free school kitchen and would be very grateful for your support.

Dear Parents/Carers,

KidSafe UK is a safeguarding programme for children which your child will soon be receiving. All materials are age appropriate and are delivered without shattering children's innocence.

All work is done in an age appropriate, fun and non-scary way through a variety of media including the use of KS our puppet, games, and worksheets.

The KidSafe programme deals with building children's confidence and self esteem and equips them with effective skills to deal with unsafe situations. KidSafe enables children to value themselves and others and helps them to make wise and healthy choices in their lives. KidSafe teaches children to recognise abuse of all types and helps to prevent it happening in the first place. They learn what is appropriate and what is not appropriate.

Topics covered during the course include:- Raising self confidence; feelings and talking about our feelings; bullying; respecting our bodies; inappropriate touching; secrets; communication skills; assertion – saying No; computer/internet safety; age ratings on DVDs and computer games; how it feels to hear arguing; looking after our mental health and emotional well-being.

You will receive a letter following each session children are taught detailing what has been covered. Please note that these letters will be shared via your child's Class Dojo. You must be signed up to access the School Story section of Class Dojo to view these. If you would prefer to have a paper copy of the letters then please inform your child's class teacher who will be happy to print you a copy.

We ran this programme for the first time last year which was a great success and really well received by the children. If you would like more information about the KidSafe programme please contact the school office.
