School Uniform

Please ensure that your child's clothing is clearly labelled with their full name. Please let teachers know via Dojo if your child is missing an item of clothing and we will endeavour to find it for you. We currently have a lot of lost property (unlabelled uniform) that will be put in the staff room on Thursday 29th September at the beginning and end of the school day. This is accessed via the front doors to the right of the main entrance, so please come and claim any of your child's missing clothes, otherwise they will be disposed of.

Class Dojo

Dojo is a fabulous way for school to keep in touch with you and vice versa. However, teachers, including myself, do not always access Dojo throughout the day so if you do message us we are unlikely to read the message until the end of the day.

If you have any concerns about your child that we need to know about urgently, please phone the school office on 01429 272684 between 8.00am and 4.30pm; they will ensure that both the teacher and myself are made aware of any problem. In addition to this, if you message the teacher, or myself, after the end of the school day, please do not expect a reply after 5pm. Staff are able to put a 'quiet time' on Dojo, so their messages will not come through until the next day.

Wake Up and Shake Up

The playground gates, opposite St Luke's Church, are opened at 8.30am to allow pupils in Years 3/4/5/6 to join in Wake Up and Shake Up. Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 children come into school via the front door. If your child comes into school before 8.45am, they are expected to join in the Wake Up and Shake Up. The gate will be locked at 8.55am and any child coming into school after that will have to come in the front door and an accompanying adult must fill in a late form.

End of the school day

Thank you for your continued patience as we iron out small blips when collecting children. If you have a child in Reception and another year group, we have an arrangement for the older child to come to the front yard and parents can collect both children from the same area. Please phone the school office to be added to the list of children who need collecting from Year 1 and above. Please wait on the yard itself, to avoid congestion and keep our children safe.

<u>Dogs</u>

I appreciate that many of you use the school run to walk your dogs but we have had some complaints that the dogs are blocking the paths when children are trying to get past and into the school gates. Can you please ensure your dog is away from the gate to allow children to pass easily, especially as some children are scared of dogs. Thank you for your understanding. Please do not bring dogs onto the yard, even if they are being carried, in line with the school Health and Safety Policy.

Breakfast Club/Munchkins

Just a reminder about our out-of-school clubs. Breakfast Club runs from 7.45am every morning until the beginning of school and Munchkins is from the end of the school day until 5.30pm, every day. The school office closes at 4.30pm so parents collecting children are asked to bring their mobile into school with them to ring the Munchkins staff.
