Children will be taught a variety of playground style games both indoors and outdoors and will be given a chance to practice these amongst themselves.

- **BOOK CLUB (Mrs Griffiths)**

We will be reading and discussing a variety of books/texts including fiction, non-fiction and poetry and do book related activities in a relaxed atmosphere. The children will be invited to bring in and talk about their own favourite books and the teacher will do so too. Each session will end with a story-time.

- **ORIGAMI CLUB (Mrs Clark)**

Origami, the ancient art of paper folding, is suitable for anyone of any age to learn. Amongst other skills it develops hand-eye co-ordination, sequencing skills, mathematical reasoning, memory and spatial awareness. If you have a passion for folding and making beautiful objects out of paper, Origami Club is definitely the after school activity for you!

- **CODING CLUB (Mr Shefford)**

STEM stands for Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics. At the STEM club, children will build models which illustrate scientific principles, and which they take home when they are complete.

The models are made largely from everyday materials, like lolly sticks and elastic bands, which are provided as part of the club. The children will learn to use tools and to work with different materials. Example projects include a balloon powered car and a "vibrating bug" powered by an electric motor.
