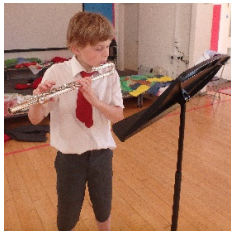

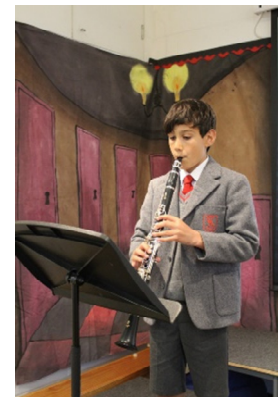
FLUTE & CLARINET LESSONS
