YEAR 2

We've had lots of fun (and challenging!) times in Art in Year 2 over the last couple of weeks as we've been

weaving the story of Holy Week. Each child chose two colours to represent Palm Sunday, Maundy Thursday, Good Friday and Easter Sunday. Some ideas included green for palm leaves, red and brown for the bread and wine, grey for the nails on the cross, blue for Mary's tears, gold for celebration and white for new life. The children planned their work carefully and took to weaving beautifully! Thank you to some of the mums for giving up their time to come and help us detangle and re-thread!



As part of our learning about habitats in Science, the children have made their own diorama habitats in boxes. They are so creative and absolutely brilliant!



YEAR 4

Year 4 have been learning about the digestive system in their Science lessons this week. The children investigated how food is digested by squeezing some crushed up food mixed with orange juice (acting as the stomach acid) through the leg of a pair of tights! This process represented the food passing through the small intestine. A very messy investigation but a great insight into the inner workings of our bodies!



YEAR 6

In their art lessons this week, children in Year 6 have been working hard, learning how to print repeat patterns with more than one colour. They have created some designs for wallpaper that are really stunning.

In English lessons, children have used the skills that they have learnt in the last few weeks whilst studying The Firework Maker's Daughter to write fabulously creative sequels to the story.

In Maths children have been investigating how to find the area of triangles and parallelograms.
