In English lessons, we have been working on traditional tales, in particular Little Red Riding Hood. We used 'Talk for Write' to learn our own version of the story off by heart with ambitious vocabulary and exciting story language. We re-told the story with actions and performed our version to the Year 2 parents and to some of the younger classes.



In Science we have been learning about how to keep ourselves healthy. We carried out an investigation to see how far a "sneeze" would travel and then carried out another investigation to discover the best way to wash our hands after using green glitter to represent the "germs"! It was very messy as the germs managed to get EVERYWHERE but it was certainly great fun!



YEAR 3

In Year 3 we have been learning about the Rainforests in Geography and, as part of their half-term homework, the children were asked to make a model of a rainforest.
