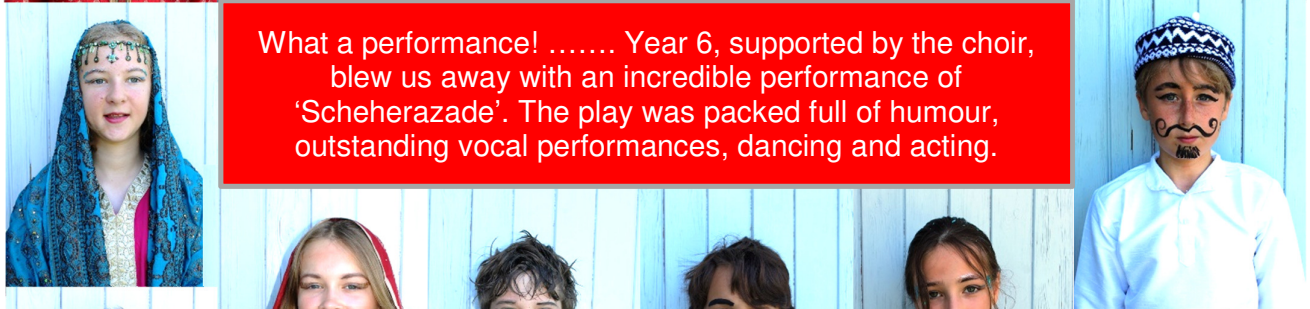




Y6 & Choir Musical Production 'Scheherazade'
