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# YEAR 4




Year 4's class assembly today was based on the theme of Advent. We learnt about the significance of the Advent wreath and why this is such a special and important time of the year. The children delivered their lines with true professionalism and entertained us all. You should be very proud of your performance Year 4 - very well done!



## YEAR 5

As part of their English unit on Classic Poetry, Year 5 have been studying the narrative poem 'The Walrus and The Carpenter' by Lewis Carroll. They learnt the plot of the poem and identified its poetic features: similes, repetition, alliteration, adverbs and personification. The children then looked at features of newspapers: catchy headlines; sub headlines; introductory paragraphs; writing using reported speech; eyewitness accounts and pictures with captions. Using these writing skills, the class then went on to create their own newspaper reports, describing the events of that fateful night when the young oysters were tricked by the Walrus and the Carpenter which led to their untimely end! The results were fantastic and the class showed themselves to be budding journalists! Year 5 also chose to perform the poem for Sacred Heart's Variety Show for Children In Need. Their acting and public speaking skills were absolutely brilliant and they skilfully showed how much they had understood the characters and the story. Excellent work, Year 5!
