Another busy and exciting week at Sacred Heart School where learning is fun!

Year 5 have started to program code in SNAP this term. The code looks very similar to Scratch and they are learning how to convert Morse Code into sounds and letters using SNAP. So far they have created coding to turn dots and dashes from Morse Code into sound and this week they have been converting letters into Unicode numbers.



As this is the most complex programming language that the children have used so far, they

for mistakes. Whilst this is not the most exciting part of coding, it is essential work and because of this support and attention to

detail, most of them have been successful in these complex programming tasks. Over the rest of the

term they will be creating further procedures to convert text into Morse Code and then play it back as sounds.

Year 5 are enjoying the challenge, and are gaining useful insights into the skills, focus and concentration required to develop more complex coding.
