In our Art lesson this week we began our project on autumn leaves. We went out looking for leaves starting to change colour but found we were a bit restricted as a lot of the trees were behind the MUGA pitch fencing! We decided instead

to focus on the Horse Chestnut tree. We took the leaves back to the classroom and looked at them very carefully using magnifying glasses and a microscope. We thought carefully about how big the leaf would need to be on our page and we took care to use sketching lines rather than solid lines. Some

of us used shading in our drawings to show the light and dark patches of the

leaves. Next week we will be moving on to using colour when drawing our autumn leaves and are hopeful we may be able to find a wider variety of leaves to work from!
