# RECEPTION

Reception have been thoroughly enjoying their learning in Phonics. For the 'm' phoneme we read sounds with magnifying glasses, mark making in the mousse and explored the magnetic marbles. For 'd' we practiced our letter shapes by dotting and using dough, as well as playing with the diggers, dinosaurs and the dolls house. For 'g' we painted grapes, read g words on grass and a particular favourite was the rather messy green goo activity. In Maths, we used leaves to practise our counting and subitising.



# YEAR 6

In spite of the weather, Children in Year 6 had a wonderful morning building waterproof bivouacs in the drizzle, and learning how to light a fire during their Outdoor Learning session this week. They enjoyed making toast and keeping warm!



As part of our new RE curriculum, children have been studying The Second Creation Story. They have created artwork which explains their understanding of the metaphor and poetry of the story in the Book of Genesis. They have also had the opportunity to plan a whole class liturgy in groups, writing prayers, explaining the scripture and setting up some beautiful prayer focus arrangements.







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
