### RECEPTION

Reception have been thoroughly enjoying their learning in phonics. For the 'm' phoneme they read sounds with magnifying glasses, explored a map (small world) and marble painting. For 'g' they made grapes and a particular favourite was the rather messy green goo activity. This week we have been looking at the sounds for 'c' and 'k', we have made cakes, caught fish, castle play, designed kites and crowns for the king. We have also continued our topic of senses and enjoyed a smelling activity.



Year 2 have had lots of fun in Maths this week using rulers to measure classroom items using centimetres.



In ICT, we have been looking at the artist, Mondrian and then, using a Colour Magic programme we created our own Mondrian pictures.



### YEAR4



Year 4 have been making electrical circuits this week in Science. We have been learning about how circuits must be complete for a bulb to light up. Any gaps or mistakes in the circuit means the electricity will be unable travel around the circuit. The children had to make predictions about certain circuits and then build them to test whether their predictions were correct or not. Great work, Year 4!



## YEAR 6

Children in Year 6 having been enjoying learning about the Ancient Greeks. They have learnt how Democracy was founded in Athens and they have been comparing the ancient system to our modern one. They were surprised to learn that women had no say in how the state was run in ancient times. For homework, they have been able to choose from a range of exciting activities: making cakes and delicious bread, writing raps, researching masks and the theatre as well as the Greek number system.



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
