# ***Another busy and exciting week at Sacred Heart School where learning is fun!***

## **FOUNDATION STAGE**

Reception and Nursery 2s went for a walk this to week to explore our local environment. We crossed roads safely looking left and right; we saw sheep and we looked at road names and house numbers.



## **YEAR 1**

Year One have shared the important story of Pentecost with their friends and families. They explained how the coming of the Holy Spirit gave the disciples the courage to go and spread the Good News and how this means that Pentecost is the birthday of the Church. They retold the story, said special prayers and danced in honour of this special Church celebration.







## YEAR 3



In Science, our topic this term is Plants. As part of this learning, we have looked at the many ways in which seeds are dispersed and the children designed posters to show the seven ways in which this is done. They are really bright, eye-catching and informative!

## YEAR 5

Year 5 have been reading a range of stories by Shaun Tan, which have fantastic illustrations often telling part of the story. They really enjoyed the story "Cicada" and made their own information posters about cicadas and their lifecycle. This really helped them to understand the story, which compares elements of working in an office to the insect lifecycle. Many of his stories also raise issues about being different and being an outsider and reactions to this. Year 5 have enjoyed debating these issues and thinking about how we treat those in society who are different, and

whether we sometimes bully, ignore or exclude some people just because they don't look like us and maybe they have different behaviours and customs. Everyone really enjoyed the story of "The Lost Thing" and children created their own "Lost Things"; they drafted original designs and detailed descriptions for them. The next step in our English topic is to write short stories, with illustrations, which copy aspects of Shaun Tan's style.

We have been learning about square and cube numbers in Maths, and children worked in pairs and then bigger groups to try to create the largest square numbers they could

using bricks. Some groups managed to get to 6 cubed which was an incredible 126 bricks!

This week we also harvested our potatoes and there was an amazing crop! Every child got 5 or 6 potatoes each. We are looking forward to seeing photos of them enjoying eating them!
