We started celebrating the day with number games and challenges. We then enjoyed making spiral number snakes, skip counting in 2s, 5s, 10s and even 4s and 6s, all the way to the centre of the snake. Can you work out how many segments there were in our snake, if you know that the respective final numbers were 48, 120, 240, 96 and 144?

Jumping to 100 gave us a much-needed extra movement break, followed by a delicious chocolate chip biscuit as a special 100th day treat. We are now continuing our daily Maths count, looking forward to reaching our next target, the 150th day of school!
