MUSIC – FLUTE & CLARINET

GOOD SHEPHERD CELEBRATION

On 22nd June, Millie, Alissia, Eloise, Lorenzo, Felicity, Leonor, Matty and Rose went to Arundel Cathedral to take part in the Good Shepherd Celebration. All the Catholic schools in our diocese came together to join Bishop Richard in a celebration of readings, prayers, dancing and wonderful singing with the theme of Jesus being our Good Shepherd. It really was a joyous occasion! Sacred Heart School were honoured to be asked to do all the readings for this service and the children could not have been more brilliant! They really rose to the challenge of reading in a Cathedral, taking into account the acoustics and the fact that there was a huge congregation. We received many comments afterwards from other schools about how beautifully all our children read; Mrs Gabriel and Mrs Rainbow were extremely proud of them: they were fantastic ambassadors for our school. As well as enjoying this opportunity to come together as a diocese, all the schools were able to hand over a cheque for £4,727.33 to Missio, the Pope's charity for World Mission that gives hope to the poorest children around the world.
