




## YEAR 3




# YEAR 4





Year 5 have been drawing and interpreting Graphs in their Maths work this week. They have been focusing on plotting graphs with constant rates and understanding intermediate values. They have used this to then convert distances and measurements. The more accurate their graphs, the more accurate the conversion and so this called for a lot of precision and concentration. This was tricky at first, but all the children were able to draw precise graphs by the end of the unit and their conversions became more and more accurate. Well done for your hard work Year 5!



This week in Year 6, children have been learning about Catholic Social Teaching and how we can make a difference through living out its values. They have written new prospectuses for our school which explain how these values are actually lived out in our school as well as writing pages for a book which describe how they can 'change the world for the good of all'.

In Geography children have been writing the lyrics for a national anthem and designing flags for their islands. They have thought carefully about the symbolism in national flags.
