## SCIENCE DAY



This week is British Science Week and in celebration of this, the children enjoyed a Science Day in school. The day started with a fun-filled assembly led by a scientist from Science Boffins who engaged the children with a variety of 'magic' tricks all of which turned out to have a scientific explanation behind them! The children watched Squiddy diving in a bottle, water seeming to disappear and change colour, elephant toothpaste being made as well as flames 'magically' reigniting. Following on from this, children in all classes enjoyed further teacher-led activities in their classrooms and a workshop with our visiting scientist, Mark. The children in KS1 learnt all about polymers and made their own pots of slime to take home. The children in KS2 learnt all about the States of Matter focusing on gases and plasma.
