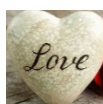

POLITE REMINDER

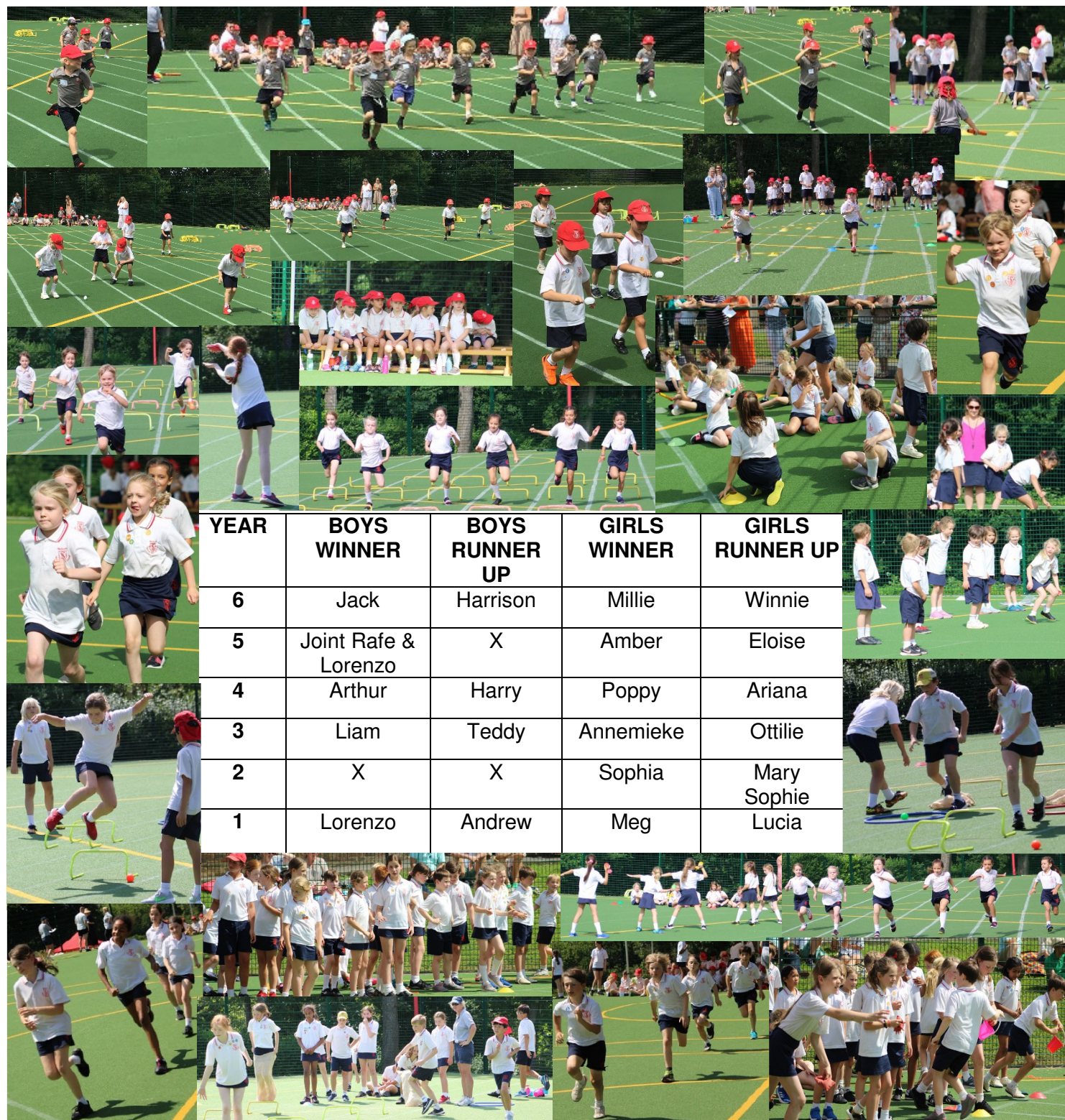
