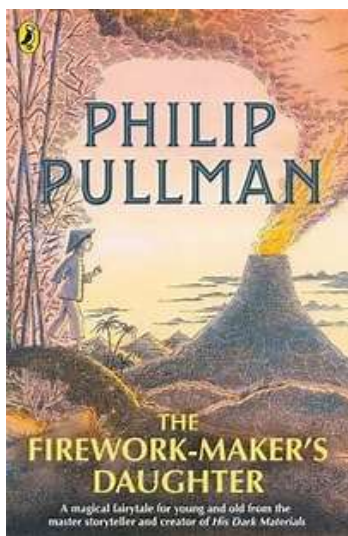
Another busy and exciting week at Sacred Heart School where learning is fun!
