RESULTS: Sacred Heart School were placed second

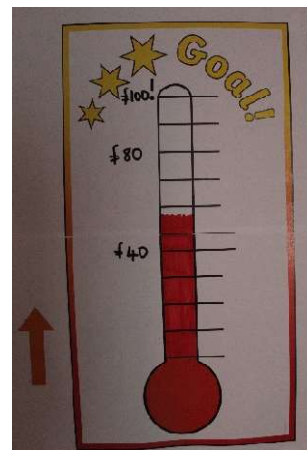

PRACTISE FOR PENNIES CAMPAIGN

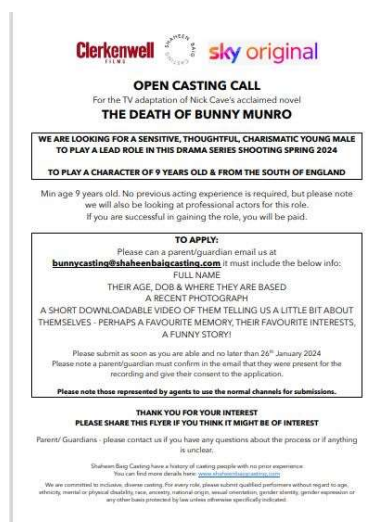
Our fundraising campaign for a school glockenspiel continues! We have raised a total of **£45.13** towards our target of **£120.00!**

RECEPTION



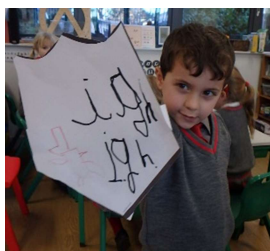
The weather has certainly been appropriate for Reception Class' learning about Winter. We have enjoyed learning about snowflakes and that each one is different, like us! We have made snowmen, explored messy snow play and created beautiful wintery trees. We have also shared the book 'Robin's Winter Song' which led to us creating caves for a bear to hibernate in.



In Maths, we enjoyed making odd one out games. We then swapped these with our friends to see if they could identify the odd one out.



In Phonics, we have been learning the 'igh' trigraph. We made shields and became knights and wrote with secret pens, where we could only read our words using a light.



YEAR 5

Year 5 really enjoyed finishing off their UFO recounts which are now on display in the classroom. They all imagined that there had been a UFO landing in their local area and that they were eye witnesses, writing a recount detailing exactly what they saw. They used their imaginations to write some fabulous descriptions and explain how the UFO sighting affected them and their families. As part of the project, they also created UFO hoax photographs to go with their recounts and these, together with their recounts, make a really fabulous classroom display.

They also finished off their Science topic, 'Earth, Sun and Moon', by thinking about different time zones around the world. They examined time zone maps and atlases to find cities in four different time zones. They then created a model of the earth, using a netball, wool (to mark out time zones in 6 hour sessions) and stickers to mark their chosen cities. This was a fun and practical way to visualise and understand the concept of time zones and it really helped them to understand why there are different time zones in different parts of the world.

They are now enjoying their new topics in English; reading and writing short stories and finding out all about lifecycles of plants in Science.
