I can touch a silky, graceful dress that feels smooth and tickly against my skin (Kamila)


I can touch a soft, fluffy kitten that is as light as a feather (Amelie)

YEAR 3

In our Science lessons this term, we are studying Rocks and Soils. Part of our learning was to discover how fossils are formed. The class then made their own 'mould and cast' fossil by creating a mould from clay, pressing a shape into this using either a shell or dinosaur part and then filling the mould with Plaster of Paris. They were very pleased with how realistic they looked! We wondered what archaeologists of the future might think when they dig up our fossils!





Our Year 3 children have also been learning the art of Maypole Dancing in school, during their PE lessons. This is in preparation for the local Wadhurst Maypole Fair in May.

CANDLEMAS ASSEMBLY

Boys and girls in Reception Class and Year 6 collaborated to present a wonderful assembly which explained to the whole school and visitors the significance of Candlemas which is also called 'The Presentation of the Lord'. They really enjoyed working together to create art and crafts as well as acting out the story from the Gospel of Luke. Their audience also learnt a great deal about the symbols of the season. Did you know that snow drops (often associated with Candlemas) are the first sign of the coming of Spring and they give us hope of lighter days ahead, just as Jesus leads us out of the darkness into His light.


