FEAST OF SACRED HEART



Today we celebrated our special school feast day: The Feast of Sacred Heart. We started the day with a whole school Celebration of the Word and each class participated in this, from Nursery Class setting up the prayer focus, Year 2 children playing the handbells during one of the hymns, and other classes



sharing Gospel readings, the meaning of the image of the Sacred Heart and explaining what love looks like to them.
