- \*STEM CLUB: Mr Shefford STEM stands for Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics. At the STEM club, children build models which illustrate scientific principles, and which they usually take home when they are complete. Most models are made largely from everyday materials like lolly sticks and elastic bands with some additional components like motors and bulbs. These are provided as part of the club. The children will learn to use tools and construction kits and to work with different materials. Previous projects have included elastic band powered cars, torches, fidget spinners, fire engines, catapults, helicopters, compasses and various toys powered by electric motors. The cost for each session, including materials, is £7.00.
