CLUB DESCRIPTIONS

PLAYGROUND GAMES: (Miss Turner)

Children will be taught a variety of playground style games both indoors and outdoors and will be given a chance to practice these amongst themselves.

SEWING CLUB: (Mrs Stanley)

Children will take on various sewing and craft projects across the term.

*FOREST SCHOOL: (Mrs Cobb)

We will be fire lighting, craft making, building dens, planting, playing games and lots of other fun outdoor activities.

• *SKILLS FOR LIFE: (Mr Shefford)

Teaching children essential skills for growing up including safety, healthy eating, exercise, first aid, bicycle maintenance, map reading and making money. The cost for each session, including materials, is £7.00.

*FREESTYLE DANCE: (Mrs Rainbow) - catherinebellingerschool@gmail.com Booking Link for Freestyle Dance

Our Freestyle dance classes give children the opportunity to learn short fun dance routines to a variety of music. These include pop songs, musicals and instrumental music. Children will have the opportunity to work towards exams, which include rosettes, stars and medals. All children will be invited to perform in our annual production at Trinity.

BOOK CLUB: (Mrs Griffiths)

We will be reading and discussing a variety of books/texts including fiction, non-fiction and poetry and do book related activities in a relaxed atmosphere. The children will be invited to bring in and talk about their own favourite books and the teacher will do so too. Each session will end with a story-time.

*COMPUTING CLUB: (Mr Shefford)

This club will give children time to explore programmes like Scratch and Junior Scratch which teach the children about coding and encourage them to become more adept at using computers constructively. The cost for each session is £3.00.

KS2 CHOIR/MUSIC CLUB: (Mrs Wibberley)

Music Club will explore a mixture of music skills - from singing in the choir to music literacy and tuned percussion playing skills. Our goal is to perform special items at important events such as the annual Harvest Festival and Christmas Carol Services. Older KS2 children will be able to lead and mentor the younger KS1 children.

*BUSHCRAFT CLUB: (Mr King)

We will be fire lighting, craft making, building dens, planting, playing games and lots of other fun outdoor activities.

*STEM CLUB: (Mr Shefford)

STEM stands for Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics. At the STEM club, children will build models which teach the children about science and technology. Previous projects have included torches, fidget spinners, fire engines, catapults, helicopters, and toys powered by electric motors. The cost for each session, including materials, is £7.00.

*REASONING SKILLS CLUB: (Mrs Root):

This Club specifically caters to those pupils who are intending to sit the Kent Selection Tests (11+) and/or Independent School entrance exams in Year 6. The pace and content of the sessions mean that it is not appropriate for all pupils. If you are in any doubt, please speak to Mrs Root in the first instance. Parents will be invoiced for practice materials used in the sessions (approximately £18 per term). Verbal and non-verbal practice will continue within the regular school day. This Club is a continuation from Spring Term.

NATURE CLUB: (Miss Megarry)

In Nature Club we will spend time outside getting closer to the natural world around us. We will cover a range of activities from collecting, drawing and planting, hopefully enjoying some sunny weather!

*DRAMA CLUB: (Mrs Holly Seymour)

We will play drama games - work towards a termly performance to show parents with the aim of building confidence and performance skills.

DOODLE CLUB: (Mrs Barber)

The children will explore their artistic skills through doodling activities. Each session encourages imagination and self-expression, helping students develop their drawing abilities while also having fun.
