### Mrs Wroblewski's Message

Dear Parents

Welcome back to our final half term of the academic year. I hope you had a lovely half-term break.

Looking ahead to the new academic year, you will all have received a letter explaining the new school structure for the year ahead. You will see that there are some changes planned.

Next week, from 9 June, our Y1 pupils will have their phonics screening check and Y4 will be taking their multiplication tables check. We will also be having our annual Trust Mass and the statue of Our Lady of Lourdes will arrive in our school for three days. This is part of the Lancaster Diocese's Centenary celebrations and the statue is visiting every primary school and secondary school in the diocese. Our week concludes with a special procession to mark the feast of Corpus Christi.

Next week we are also holding our annual Induction Evening for parents of pupils starting Reception and Nursery in September. St. Clare's continues to be a highly popular first choice of primary school in the area and is once again oversubscribed.

Looking further ahead, Monday 16 June will be our Walk to School Week, which also coincides with the Youth Sport Trust National Sports Week. To celebrate, we are organising a range of events including a visit from Deepdale Duck – please see the note from Mr. Cummings later in this newsletter.
