acute	An angle between 0 and 90 degrees.
obtuse	An angle between 90 and 180 degrees.
quadrilateral	A four sided 2D shape.
perpendicular	When lines meet at right angles (90 degrees)
parallel	When lines have the same distance between them continuously so will never meet.
axis	A fixed line at the edge of a graph showing the position of a point.
pitch	The position of a single sound in the complete range of sound that enables us to judge sounds as 'higher' or 'lower'.
duration	The amount of time a note, phrase, section, or composition lasts.
tempo	The rate of speed of a musical piece.
